**T**hank you for your interest in the Professional Development/Scholarship Opportunities for Washington State Treatment Providers to attend the Second Annual *Four Directions* Tribal Problem Gambling Awareness Conference – to be held September 29-October 2 at the Tulalip Resort. The 2010 Washington State Treatment Provider professional development scholarships were established to encourage and support participation by professionals who have applied to become a Washington State Certified Gambling Counselor and who hold a current certificate or license issued by the State of Washington to provide mental health or chemical dependency treatment services to the public. Applications for certification are available online at [www.evergreencpg.org](http://www.evergreencpg.org) or call the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling at 360.352.6133. Treatment Providers with applications on file by September 1, 2010 are eligible. There are a limited number of professional development scholarships available (total value up to \$319) to include:

- Full conference registration for September 30-October 1
- Pre-conference Basic Training on September 29 (a required Core Course for Washington State Problem Gambling Counselor Certification).
- Post-conference National Problem Gambling Exam Preparation Course on October 2. (A passing score on the National Exam is a requirement for Washington State and National Problem Gambling Counselor Certification.)
- Professional Development scholarships will include a one-year membership in the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling.

Note: lodging costs, meals, and travel expenses are the responsibility of the attendee.

- Have a completed Washington State Problem Gambling Counselor Certification application on file with the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling by September 1, 2010.
- Hold a current certificate or license issued by the State of Washington to provide mental health or chemical dependency treatment services to the public.

## **Awards:**

Applications will be judged (with any identifying information deleted) by a special committee of the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling.

Professional Development Scholarship recipients will be notified by September 3, 2010.

## **Deadline:**

Completed certification application form and supporting documentation, together with a completed conference registration form, must all be postmarked by September 1, 2010. Applications received after this date will be considered only if funding is still available.
